TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

GUARANTEE:

Norview Gardens Ltd. guarantees our stock to be in healthy condition upon leaving our facility. Beyond that we cannot be held responsible for stock that does not grow, as we have no control over conditions outside of our facility. We warrant our stock to be true to name. Should any stock prove to be untrue to name we will replace it or return amount paid for such stock. We shall in no case be liable for any sum greater than the amount originally received for the said plant material.

TERMS:

30 days credit is extended only to clients with established credit. 2% per month (24% per annum) will be charged on overdue accounts.

For accounts that are past due 60 days, terms are COD only and any available discounts will be forfeited until the account is brought current.

PRICING:

All prices are FOB our nursery located in Norwich, Ontario, Canada and are subject to change without notice. Packaging, tags, shipping charges, applicable taxes, and any other accessorial charges are not included in the base price of the said plant and will be added at time of shipping. Patented plants require a royalty fee which will be added to the cost as a separate line item.

PRICING DISCOUNTS:

Volume discounts are awarded based on the number of trays purchased. The levels of applicable discounts can be found on the order form. Discounts are only awarded to accounts in good standing.

PAYMENT:

We accept payment by cheque, electronic funds transfer (EFT), and e-transfer. All payments must be made in Canadian funds.

PACKING:

All packing material, whether boxes or one-way wooden shipping racks, will be billed to customer at cost. Wood racks are non-returnable but are reusable. For local deliveries done by our own truck we will use our metal rolling racks.

SHIPPING:

Local shipping: Delivery can be arranged with our own trucks or customers may choose to pick up their order. If picking up, please give us at least 48 hours' notice to ensure your order will be ready.

Long distance shipping: We may use various courier companies or Canada Post for smaller orders, and LTL truck services for larger orders that are shipped on skids or racks. For LTL, please ensure you have a loading dock able to handle transport trucks or a forklift to off load.

Shipments may be delayed under extreme weather conditions or other conditions beyond our control. We will do our best to get the shipment out as soon as conditions allow. We are in no way liable for plant material damaged in shipping and/or delay in transit. Such issues are the responsibility of the carrier and should be addressed with the carrier.

CLAIMS:

Check plants immediately upon arrival at your location. No claims will be entertained for deficiencies or rejections of stock unless made within three days of arrival. Please carefully inspect condition of goods received for damaged skids, boxes, or racks, frozen product or other obvious abuse of product prior to signing the delivery slip. Once the delivery slip is signed by the receiver no claims can be made regarding the freight handling.

ORDER DETAILS:

 Liners/plugs are shipped in full trays only and are available in plug sizes of 72, 50, and 40 plants per tray as indicated on the order form. For example, if you require 200 plugs/liners of a 72 size please order 216 plants (3 trays). Each tray consists of one variety – no mixed trays.

- 1L pots must be ordered 10/tray per species
- 15cm pots must be ordered 8/tray per species
- 2 gallon pots may be ordered individually



Native N.A. wetland plant with attractive, upright foliage providing a vertical focal point in natural or man-made water features. Plant in shallow margins of water or bog garden.


Acorus gramineus 'Oborozuki'

Eastern Asia. Has eye-catching, upright, yellow-striped foliage. Thrives in the shallow edges of streams and ponds.

Golden, variegated foliage with golden seed spikes. Slow spreading with a low-growing mat-like habit. Water regularly. Excellent show planted with spring bulbs.





Andropogon gerardii

Big Bluestem





A robust, American native, clump-forming grass that produces dense, feathery flower panicles above many stems of wide leaves. Turns bronze-red after frost. Flowers resemble a turkey's foot.


Andropogon gerardii 'Blackhawks'

Big Bluestem



Dark green foliage that turns to purples, burgundies, and reds by mid-summer, intensifying even more into fall. Introduced by Intrinsic Perennial Gardens.

Propagation strictly prohibited. PP27949





Andropogon gerardii 'Dancing Wind'

Big Bluestem



Blue-green, upright foliage turns to a brilliant scarlet by autumn. From Intrinsic Perennial Gardens. PP26892

Andropogon gerardii 'Indian Warrior'

Big Bluestem



Tall, upright clumps of green foliage that turn to purplish tones late summer into fall. Deep purple inflorescence. From Intrinsic Perennial Gardens. PP24999





Andropogon gerardii 'Red October'

Big Bluestem




Deep green foliage turning to reds and burgundies into fall. Outstanding late season color. From Intrinsic Perennial Gardens. PP26283

Andropogon virginicus

Broomsedge



A native clump-forming grass producing dense, feathery flower panicles above many stems of wide leaves. Excellent choice for mass plantings or as a dried flower.





Arrhenatherum bulbosum 'Variegatum'

Striped Tuber Oat Grass



Variegated green-white clumps, serving well as a groundcover. Performs better in cooler climates. Cut back during summer heat.

Bouteloua curtipendula

Side Oats Grama





Fine-leaved, sod-forming native grass producing delicate seed heads above graceful foliage. Excellent in meadows or prairie gardens.







Bouteloua gracilis

Blue Grama



Foliage height: 50-60 cm Foliage width: 25-30 cm Bloom height: 60 cm Flowering time: Summer

One of the most important prairie grasses, standing only 30 cm tall when in flower. Drought tolerant, thriving in full sun and dry conditions.



Calamagrostis brachytricha

Korean (Autumn) Feather Reed Grass



Foliage height:90 cm Foliage width: 60-90 cm Bloom height: 125 cm Flowering time: Late summer - fall

Easily grown, forming an upright, arching clump topped with rosy-purple spikes appearing in September. Flower spikes can be useful in floral arrangements or left in the garden for unusual winter interest.


Calamagrostis canadensis

Canada Bluejoint



Foliage height: 100 cm Foliage width: 80-120 cm Bloom height: 150 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

Native, clump-forming prairie grass with blue-green foliage. Early blooms are pink-green turning to tan later in the season. Grows best in wet soils beside streams or ponds.





Calamagrostis stricta

Northern Reed Grass



Foliage height: 60-120 cm Foliage width: 80-120 cm Bloom height: 150 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

A slender, clump-forming upright grass for the garden, landscape, or at water's edge. Narrow, red-bronze flower spikes dry to golden-buff color, excellent as a dried flower or left uncut for winter interest.

Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Avalanche'

Variegated Feather Reed Grass



Foliage width: 50-60 cm Bloom height: 125 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

This distinctly green and white variegated grass remains attractive all season long. Flower heads appear in early summer. Upright and clump-forming. Great in mass plantings.





Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Eldorado'

Feather Reed Grass







Foliage height: 100 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Bloom height: 150 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

The golden variegation will brighten any spot in the garden. The narrow stature of the grass reacts to the breezes, adding motion to the garden. PP16486



Deep green, clump-forming foliage. Slender, red-bronze flower spikes dry to a beautiful buff color. Perennial Plant of the Year 2001.

Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Lightning Strike'

Foliage height: 90 cm Foliage width: 60-80 cm Bloom height: 100 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

Wide, creamy-white stripe in the centre of the green leaves. Purple-pink plumes appear in summer and last well into the fall.



Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Overdam'

Variegated Feather Reed Grass



Foliage height:90 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Bloom height: 125 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

One of the finest perennial grasses, valued for its vertical growth habit and green and white variegated foliage. Produces many pinkish, feathery blooms in summer. Excellent as a specimen or in mass plantings.

Calamagrostis x acutiflora Waldenbuch'

Feather Reed Grass









Lush green foliage turns to a light yellow in fall. Has a looser habit than Karl Foerster and appears more arching. Flowers are a silvery-green that turn to a buff wheat color in the fall. Plant as a specimen or in mass plantings.





Carex appalachica

Appalachian Sedge







Foliage width: 30-45 cm Flowering time: Spring A lovely native groundcover for dry,

shady areas. Very fine, deep green, clumping foliage. Similar in many ways to Carex pensylvanica.

Carex bebbii



Foliage height: 60-80 cm Foliage width: 5-10 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

A clump-forming, fine-textured sedge that bears interesting seed heads. Excellent selection for moist shade gardens and streambanks.





Carex buchananii

Leather Leaf Sedge





Foliage height: 50-60 cm Foliage width: 30-45 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

Tufted, evergreen perennial with cinnamon-colored foliage for contrast with other garden colors. Great for mass planting. Prefers moist locations.

Carex comans 'Amazon Mist'

New Zealand Hair Sedge





Foliage height: 15-30 cm Foliage width: 30 cm Flowering time: Summer - late summer

Very fine, wispy foliage that is green on top and silvery-white below. Excellent as a filler in mixed planters or landscape beds.







Carex comosa

Longhair Sedge






Foliage width: 50-60 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

This sedge has long, green leaf blades topped with showy seedheads. Excellent choice for wetland restoration and other moist sites.

Carex crinita

Fringed Sedge





Native sedge with arching seed heads and foliage. Useful for naturalizing ditches, wet areas, or rain gardens. Provides food and cover for wildlife.



Carex dolichostachya 'Kaga Nishiki'

Gold Fountains







Foliage height: 20-25 cm Foliage width: 15-20 cm Flowering time: Spring

A spectacular sedge with graceful, variegated foliage. Useful as an accent plant in the shaded perennial garden or as a groundcover.

Carex eburnea

Bristle-Leaf Sedge







Foliage height: 15-20 cm Foliage width: 20 cm Flowering time: Spring

A low-growing native sedge ideal as a colonizing groundcover in woodland or rock gardens. Inconspicuous, white to green blooms in late spring.





Carex elata 'Aurea'

Bowles' Golden Sedge





Foliage height: 45-60 cm Foliage width: 30-40 cm Bloom height: 60 cm Flowering time: Late spring

Spectacular, vibrant sedge that bears beautiful golden foliage with a thin green margin. Makes a beautiful accent plant in the perennial garden and will brighten any deeply shaded spot.

Carex glauca 'Blue Zinger'







Foliage height: 30-40 cm Foliage width: 40-50 cm Flowering time: Late spring

Steel-blue foliage holding its color into winter. Excellent choice for a groundcover. Once established, it is drought tolerant.





Carex grayi

Gray's Sedge









Foliage height: 60-90 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Flowering time: Spring

A spectacular, semi-evergreen sedge with large, showy seed heads. Good choice for moist shade gardens. Can be used fresh or dried in arrangements.

Carex hystericina

Porcupine Sedge










Foliage height: 60-80 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Flowering time: Spring

This Carex grows well in difficult places and is found naturally in ditches, marsh perimeters, wet prairies, or swamps. Seed heads remain all summer.







Carex laxiculmis 'Hobb'

Bunny Blue™ Sedge



Foliage height: 15-30 cm Foliage width: 30-40 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

Native plant with silvery-blue, grass-like foliage. Best used as a border plant, a groundcover, in bog areas, in shade gardens, around ponds, or by streams.

Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'

Sedge







Foliage height: 30 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Flowering time: Spring

Dark green leaves with bright white edges. This sedge spreads slowly, is useful as a groundcover or in a mixed container.



Carex morrowii 'Silver Sceptre'

Variegated Sedge



Foliage height: 25-30 cm Foliage width: 30-60 cm Flowering time: Late spring - summer

Narrow leaves with white margins. Used for mass planting, border edging, groundcover, naturalizing woodland gardens, and in mixed containers.

Carex muskingumensis


Palm Sedge





Foliage height: 60-90 cm Foliage width: 45-60 cm Flowering time: Spring

Beautiful fine-textured sedge for shaded settings. Excellent as a groundcover, lawn substitute, or edging in the garden. Spreads slowly by rhizomes.





Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'

Sedge







Foliage height:30 cm Foliage width: 20-30 cm Flowering time: Spring

An eye-catching sedge with green and creamy-yellow variegated foliage. A great accent plant in the perennial garden.

Carex pensylvanica

Pennsylvania Sedge






Foliage height: 15-30 cm Foliage width: 30-45 cm Flowering time: Spring

A very popular, low-growing native sedge. Does well as a groundcover for dry woodland shade. Sometimes used as a "no-mow" lawn.

Foliage height: 20-30 cm Foliage width: 5-10 cm Bloom height: 30 cm Flowering time: Spring

A small perennial, clumping sedge with fine foliage. One small part of its green seed head has a rosey hue to it. Plant in dry to moist shade.

Carex stricta

Tussock Sedge










Foliage height: 60-90 cm Foliage width: 30-50 cm Bloom height: 90 cm Flowering time: Summer

This sedge has gracefully arching, almost fountain-like foliage. Grows well in open wet places such as marshes, along streams, by ponds, bogs, or wetlands.







Carex vulpinoidea

Fox Sedge



Foliage height: 30-90 cm Foliage width: 40-50 cm Bloom height: 90 cm Flowering time: Summer

A North American native wetland sedge. Clump-forming with seed heads emerging from the centre of the plant for an interesting effect.

Chasmanthium latifolium

Northern Sea Oats



Foliage height: 75-90 cm Foliage width: 30-60 cm Bloom height: 90 cm Flowering time: Early summer

Broad leaf blades that are dark green in shade, but lighter in a sunny location. Large, showy seed heads that are great for cut arrangements, fresh or dried.



Cortaderia selloana

White Pampas Grass



Foliage height: 250-300 cm Foliage width: 125-150 cm Bloom height: 300 cm Flowering time: Late summer

Dramatic flower plumes and towering form create a breathtaking display. Grow as an annual in the north or must be wintered indoors.


Cortaderia selloana 'Pumila'

Compact Pampas Grass



Foliage height: 100-125 cm Foliage width: 60-90 cm Bloom height: 125 cm Flowering time: Late summer

A compact Pampass Grass. Narrow, grey-green foliage topped with large silky-white plumes. Grow as an annual in the north or must be wintered indoors.





Cortaderia selloana 'Rosea'

Pink Pampas Grass





Foliage height: 250-300 cm Foliage width: 125-150 cm Bloom height: 300 cm Flowering time: Late summer

This majestic ornamental grass boasts long, pendulous, medium green grass-like leaves and tall, fluffy flowers of soft rose. Grow as an annual in the north or must be wintered indoors.


Deschampsia cespitosa

Tufted Hair Grass



Foliage height: 60-100 cm Foliage width: 60-80 cm Bloom height: 100 cm Flowering time: Early summer

Abundant sprays of delicate flowers appear early and stay attractive through the season. Plant in flower or rock gardens, at water's edge, or in open woods.





Deschampsia cespitosa 'Bronzeschleier'

Bronze Veil Tufted Hair Grass







Foliage height: 60-80 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Bloom height: 100 cm Flowering time: Early summer

Low mounds of dark green foliage topped with clouds of tiny, bronze-green flowers. Makes a good accent plant, but also used in mass plantings.

Deschampsia cespitosa 'Goldschleier'

Gold Veil Tufted Hair Grass



Foliage height: 30-60 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Bloom height: 60 cm Flowering time: Early summer

Abundant sprays of light golden-yellow flowers atop the dark green foliage. Plant in flower or rock gardens, at water's edge, or in open woods.





Deschampsia cespitosa 'Goldtau'

Golden Dew Tufted Hair Grass

Sprays of golden-yellow flowers appear early and stay attractive through the season. Lovely in cut arrangements, fresh or dried.

Deschampsia cespitosa 'Northern Lights'

Tufted Hair Grass



Foliage height: 25-30 cm
Foliage width: 40-50 cm
Bloom height: 30 cm
Flowering time: Early summer

Striking, variegated foliage compliments abundant sprays of delicate flowers all summer. Foliage is exceptionally brilliant in cool weather. Good cut flower.

Dwarf Tufted Hair Grass



Foliage height: 60-80 cm
Foliage width: 30-45 cm
Bloom height: 80 cm
Flowering time: Spring

Silver-green foliage producing silvery-white flowers. Flowers mature to a rich brown color, great for cut arrangements, fresh or dried.

Deschampsia flexuosa

Crinkled Hair Grass



Foliage height: 20-60 cm
Foliage width: 30-50 cm
Bloom height: 60 cm
Flowering time: Early summer

A more fine-textured and delicate form of the Tufted Hair Grasses. A native that thrives in dry shade. Used to naturalize sites, planted in masses.





Eleocharis obtusa

Blunt Spike Rush



Foliage height: 20-40 cm
Foliage width: 20-25 cm
Flowering time: Early summer

A hardy bog plant with attractive lime-green clumps topped with brown, button-like flowers. First to arrive in a freshly dug pond and perfect for the rain garden. Dense stands are perfect for dragonflies and frogs.

Elymus arenarius (Leymus)

Lyme Grass



Foliage height: 100 cm
Foliage width: 40-50 cm
Bloom height: 150 cm
Flowering time: Summer

Very hardy, upright, blue-grey foliage topped by blue-grey flower spikes turning to light beige. Spreads by rhizomes. In the garden, plant in containers to control spreading. Useful as a groundcover and for erosion control.





Elymus arenarius 'Blue Dune' (Leymus)

Lyme Grass








Coarse, silvery-blue foliage. Slightly arching, upright clump topped by wheat colored plumes. Very heat tolerant. Used for erosion control, hillside plantings, and container plantings.

Elymus canadensis

Canada Wild Rye



Attractive, clump-forming, cool season grass that has arching blades and greenish flower plumes.







Elymus canadensis 'Icy Blue'

Canada Wild Rye



Foliage height: 140 cm Foliage width: 60-90 cm Flowering time: Late summer

Clump-forming with blue-grey foliage producing seed heads which remain attractive long into winter. Planted on slopes for erosion control. Useful when planted as a habitat for wildlife.

Elymus virginicus

Virginia Wild Rye



Foliage height: 100-150 cm Foliage width: 50-60 cm Flowering time: Late summer

This cool season native grass has arching blades and greenish flower plumes. Terrific planted on shaded banks, fence rows, or open woodland. Drought tolerant once established.





Eragrostis spectabilis

Purple Love Grass



Foliage height: 25-60 cm Foliage width: 40-50 cm Flowering time: Late summer

This showy grass has light green foliage in summer that turns bronze-red in fall. Red to purple flowers are soft and subtle. Use as accent plant or in masses.

Erianthus ravennae (Saccharum)

Hardy Pampas Grass



Foliage height: 150-300 cm Foliage width: 125-200 cm Bloom height: 300 cm Flowering time: Late summer

Dramatic flower plumes are striking in the garden and excellent cut for dried arrangements. Beautiful specimen for a large garden, reflected in water, or in natural areas in the landscape. Not invasive.





Festuca glauca

Blue Fescue



Foliage height: 20-35 cm Foliage width: 25-30 cm Bloom height: 35 cm Flowering time: Late spring

Clump-forming, stiff, thread-like, blue foliage which produces steel-blue flower heads. Excellent choice for rock gardens, borders, or groundcover.

Festuca glauca 'Beyond Blue'

Blue Fescue
